#### **Updates on the Management of Canine Osteoarthritis**

Dr. Todd will provide a quick update on latest intestinal parasite prevalence data in dogs. He will then conduct an overview of acute pain in dogs and cats, including pain assessment and use of NSAIDs in treatment of acute pain. He will add an overview of pharmacokinetics and practical considerations in the use of Onsior (robenacoxib) in dogs and cats and provide an overview of osteoarthritis in dogs with a review or traditional methods of treatment. He then will introduce Galliprant (grapiprant), a novel treatment for OA in dogs, including the mechanism of action and practice application.
